## Eco Reader review

**Eco Reader is the first ebook reader to arrive in Australia, allowing you to read all your electronic books in a convenient format.**

The [Eco Reader](#) from Australian company Central Book Services is the device of its type to be marketed locally, so it's no longer necessary to buy an ebook reader from overseas.

The device runs on Linux and features open format file support, so it can read a wide range of files - too many to list here.

At its heart is a 15cm screen with 600x800 pixel resolution with the ability to change font and type size. Also included is 512MB of internal storage, expandable to 4GB via the SD card slot.

Eco Reader comes with 21 books pre-installed, including the likes of Dostoevsky's "Crime and Punishment" and "Wuthering Heights" by Emily Bronte.

The Eco Reader sells for \$449 and is currently available from Central Book Services in Melbourne, Dymocks George Street (Sydney) and Rundle Mall (Adelaide), Boomerang Books, Melbourne University Bookshop, Reader's Feast and Box Hill Institute Bookshop.
